Hardware Set-up

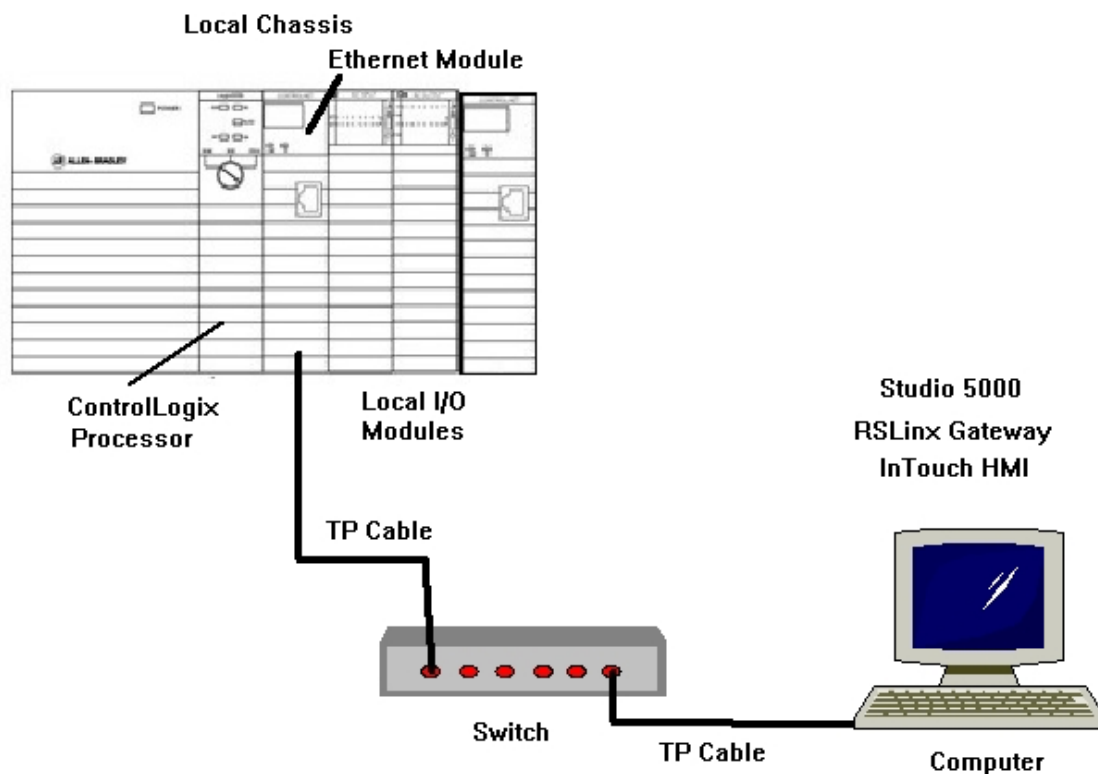


Figure 1-A. Hardware configuration for this HOA.

1. Start a new CottrolLogix Project file named – HOA_8

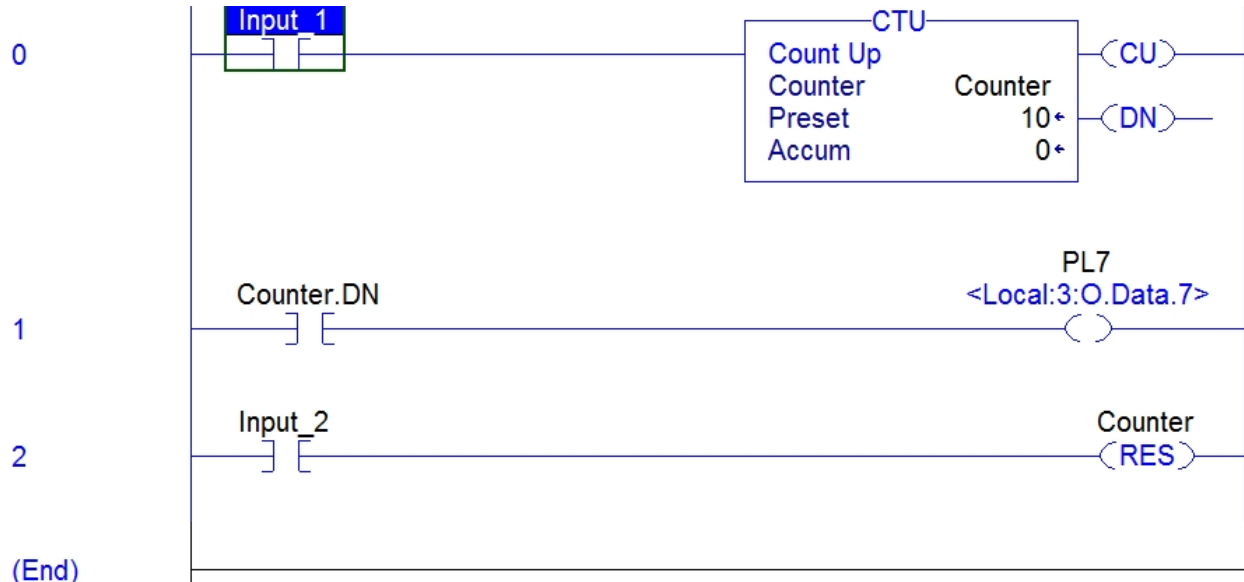


Figure 2-A. The ladder program for this HOA.

2. Program Ladder Logic as shown in Figure 2-A

3. Download HOA_8 Project File to ControlLogix processor
Place processor in RUN Mode.

4. Using RSLinx – configure a Topic called WW

5. Start a new InTouch application named Module_8_HOA

6. Create a window for the application – Replace Type window
Name the of the windows ControlLogix

7. On the window create the following objects

Rectangle object to act as a switch

- Assign Input_1 to the Rectangle object
- The rectangle object will be used to toggle the Rung 0 condition
- Use your initials as Access Name

A Wizard Light -> Light Panel Object

- The Light Panel Wizard will be RED when Counter is not done
- The Light Panel Wizard will be Green when is done

Configure a Rocker Switch Wizard object to Reset the Counter

- _____ 8. Create a Number Field object to monitor the value of the Counter Accumulated Value.
- _____ 9. Create a Number Field object to change the value of the Counter Preset Value
 - Use Keypad to enter Counter Values
 - Configure value range 0 – 20
- _____ 10. Add labels to identify object's function.
