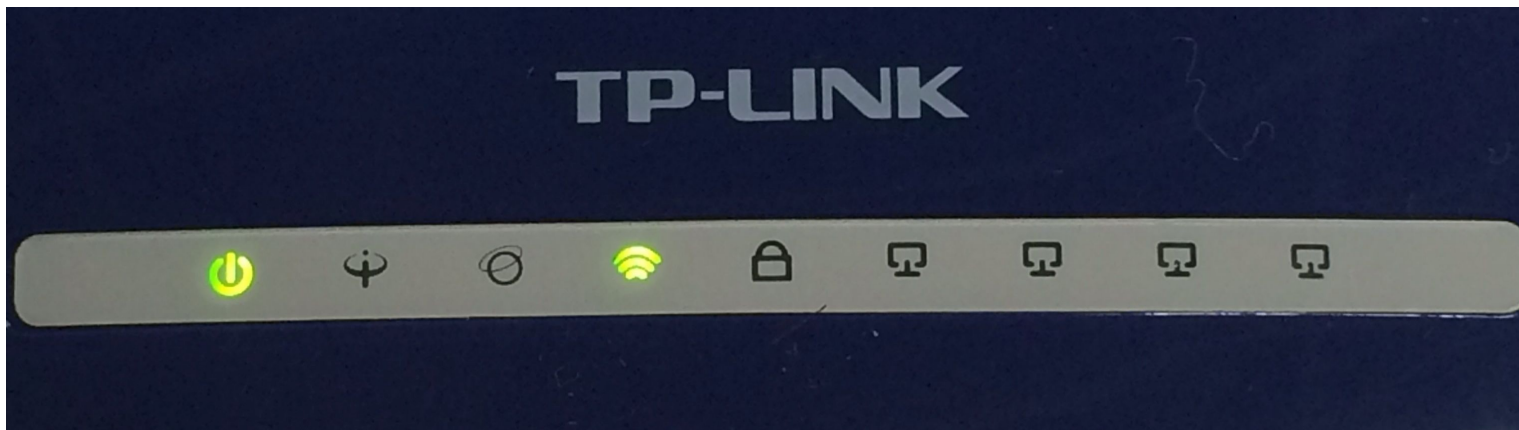


Browsers

If You Know Where You Are Going

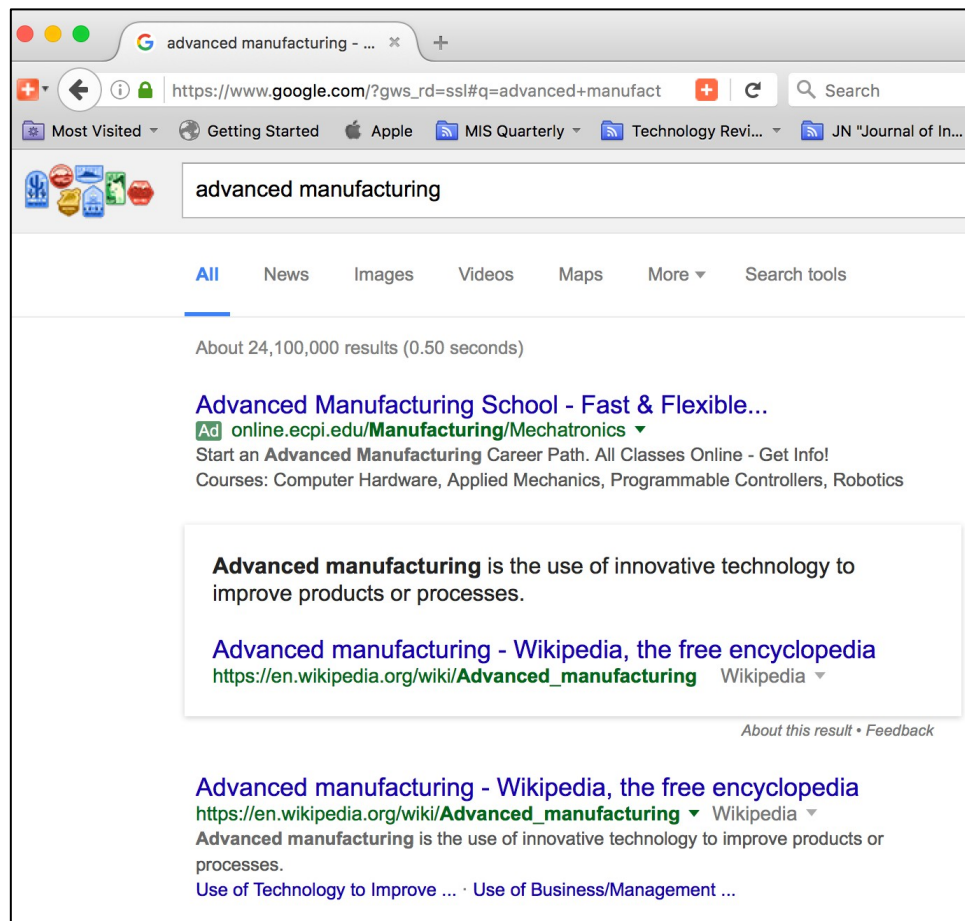
- Type into the address bar, or click a bookmark
