Maybe not that bad, but we will only scratch the surface on these topics. But hopefully you will encounter something that will serve you in the future.

#### **Assignment 9a: Themes**

You are well familiar with Themes. Previously you selected an initial Theme and then updated that Theme with a new Theme. #### **Assignment 9b: Static Pages**

Blogs are characterized by a single page that changes with your posts – usually by your information scrolling down. A website is characterized by a home page that pretty much stays constant. #### **Assignment 9c: Child Pages**
