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HTML Editing Tutorial

This tutorial will show you how to incorporate graphics into your WordPress site. Follow the instructions to complete Assignment 9f: HTML Editing.

What is HTML?

HTML stands for **H**yper**t**ext **M**arkup **L**anguage. It is a programming language specifically designed for the web.




Figure 1 Austin Community College

Plug & Edit HTML Editor




Figure 2 WordPress
