1. Answers

- Look for what functions the **Plugin** is intended to perform
- Look for how many times the **Plugin** has been downloaded
- Look for the average rating (how well people like it) of the Plugin

2. Answers

- Commercial **Plugins** are created by software developers to be used by the **WordPress** community for a fee.
- Free **Plugins** are created by software developers to be used by the **WordPress** community without cost.

3. Answers

- don't assume
- don't take anything for granted
- read carefully
- do more research than just relying on one recommendation
- <u>caveat emptor</u>: "let the buyer beware"

4. Administrative control (Control Panel) of the website

- Download the software
- Install the software
- Activate the new Plugin
